CWA District 1/IBEW Local 2213 and IBEW New England Regional Committees as well as the CWA/IBEW Mid Atlantic Regional Bargaining Committee will be returning to the Rye Town Hilton on Tuesday October 25, 2011. We left bargaining so that every CWA Local Executive Board Member in District 1 could visit every company garage, company building or be in the field to talk to every CWA member to tell them exactly what the latest company proposal would mean to their future. We told our members all the facts. Our Local Executive Board members explained to our members what must be done to fight this Company. Our members told us to shine a light on the Company's Greed and to continue to fight for a fair contract. Our members told us that they are not willing to give up 50 years of collective bargaining victories to a company that is trying to destroy the middle class while making huge profits.

Our members know the facts – all the facts.

Last Thursday, the stewards in every Local met with the members at every work location and explained to them how we will join forces with the "99% group" and the "Occupy Wall Street Group" to fight this Company.
