The Summer Camp Reimbursement program provides up to \$200 per session (Max \$400) for summer camp expenses for dependent children up to age 15. <b>Applications must be received by August 30, 2013</b> <b>Payouts:</b> Reimbursement forms are due by September 27, 2013. Reimbursements will show in employees October 26, 2013 paycheck.
